Every child in the world has the right to a childhood. It's that simple.

We all have all been children and needed support to grow. Helping children to develop is the focus of Terre des hommes Foundation. Terre des hommes Foundation was started by a former child that became a pharmacist and then created an international foundation to help children worldwide.

Our name

Terre des hommes (Land of People) is a book by Antoine de Saint Exupéry, that emphasizes our responsibility towards children.



Our mission

For more than 25 years, Terre des hommes has been helping children in Romania overcome situations that make them vulnerable (poverty, migration, contact with the justice system). We work to prevent risk situations and strengthen the capacity of adults (caregivers and professionals) to support children, by offering specific trainings. Our projects help children have access to their rights, such as education and social services, and improve the infrastructure in their environment. Every year the total number of our beneficiaries is about 10.000 children.

We are known for:

- # Movement, Game, Sports: a training method that promotes sport and play to create connections, heals and empowers children.
- # Involving children and young people in projects, making sure we address their real needs.
- # Sustainability of our projects: we work in partnership with local stakeholders to guarantee local ownership of all initiatives .

A selection of our impactful projects in Romania

SHINE: a project in Bacau County, improving the education, health, social services and infrastructure for children in 37 poor communities

Zefir: a project that helped Roma and other vulnerable groups in 12 rural communities of South West Romania gain access to education, health services, housing and employment

Take Over Day: every year we support thousands of children all over Romania to take over their dream job for a day.
